Dear Commissioners,

The Integrated Resource Plan (“IRP”) process is central to determining Georgia’s energy future—shaping decisions that will affect electricity affordability, reliability, and economic development across the state. As intervenors and stakeholders, we are committed to contributing constructively to this important proceeding. Timely access to transcripts is an important component of our ability to meaningfully engage in this process. Furthermore, we recognize that many intervenors and stakeholders do not have the financial wherewithal to independently pay for transcripts—expedited or otherwise—and we support the Commission providing transcripts to the public at large, regardless of ability to pay.

We ask the Commission to provide the public with free access to transcripts in an expedited manner, to allow stakeholders to contribute most meaningfully to these proceedings.

We believe that expediting and publicizing transcripts would greatly enhance transparency of these proceedings, improve the quality of intervenor and stakeholder participation, and support a regulatory process that benefits all parties to the IRP. **Therefore, we respectfully urge the Commission to take prompt action to make transcripts of contested proceedings—like these—available without charge to the public in an expedited manner.**

Thank you for your consideration and for your continued dedication to a fair and transparent process that will lead to better outcomes for all Georgians.
